

# PAINTING A ROOM CHECKLIST

Plan, Prepare, Paint — The Right Way

# Tools and Equipment Required

---

Paintbrushes for edges and detail work



Rollers for large wall surfaces



Painter's tape for sharp, clean edges



Drop cloths to protect floors and furniture



Ladder, primer, and sandpaper for prep



# Preparing a Room for Painting

---

Clear the room and cover the floors



Tape around edges, trims, and outlets



Patch cracks, holes, and sand surfaces



Clean walls and remove dust or grease



Ensure good ventilation before starting



# Steps to Paint the Room

---

Choose your finish: matte, eggshell, or satin



Apply primer if needed and mix paint well



Cut in edges with a brush before rolling



Use rollers for large areas with even pressure



Apply second coat if required



# Tips While Painting the Room

---

Test paint in natural light before full use



Always paint from top to bottom



Keep wipes handy for drips or spills



Let each coat dry before applying the next



Wear protective gear and take breaks



# Maintenance Tips After Painting

---

Avoid heavy wall hangings for 2 weeks



Gently clean painted surfaces with damp cloth



Touch up scuffs promptly



Keep out of direct sunlight to prevent fading



Dust walls regularly and schedule repaints
